Phytosanitary requirements for import Cicer arientinum grain

from all country to Iran

- 1- Valid phytosanitary certificate from the country of origin, in which the freeness of consignment from the following pest is indicated in the Additional Declarations (A.D):
 - Araecerus fasciculatus Broad bean mottle virus
 - Pseudomonas syringae pv. pisi Pseudomonas savastanoi pv. phaseolicola

Note: The scientific name of the above mentioned pest should be indicated in the phytosanitary certificate, otherwise; the documents are considered as incomplete. Moreover, any financial customs losses and non-delivery of the consignment due to the non-compliance are to be borne by the importer/s.

- 2- Disinfection of the consignment by Phosphine gas 1.5 g/m³ in temperature more than 15°C for 1 week in the country of origin and mentioning above features in the Treatment box of relevant phytosanitary certificate.
- 3- If the consignment is exported via a third country, the certified copy (stamped, signed and dated) of phytosanitary certificate of country of origin having all above requirements, along with the original phytosanitary certificate for re- export should be submitted to plant quarantine officers in the customs.
